

Registration Information

In order to participate in any USAG Baden-Wuerttemberg CYS Services program or to use its facilities, each family is required to register with Parent Central Services located in Building 742, Benjamin Franklin Village.

Enrollment Information

Children and youth, ages 4-15 (of active or retired military or DoD civilians working in the military community) are eligible to enroll in youth sports. Age is as designated on June 15, 2011.

Enrollment requires a current sports physical valid through the end of the season for which you are registering. Participants may register for sports subject to obtaining an updated physical. Children/youth without a valid sports physical will be tracked and will be denied participation in practices and games until the physical is provided. *Parents of children with special needs must be cleared before signing up for sports activities.

Discounts & Refunds

Head Coach—All family members enrolled in A & B sports this season (baseball, softball, soccer) play free.

Asst. Coach—One family member plays free.

Families with more than one member participating in the same season will receive a 15% discount. Refunds will be given only in the event of medical problems or PCS. Documentation is required.
